1. All teams and umpires to report by 8.30am, tournament commences 9.00am sharp.
2. Winning team to take score sheet **immediately** to tournament office. Both teams **MUST** check that scores are correct prior to handing in to office. Scores are deemed official once handed into office.
3. Finals - Age groups with more than one section will cross over to play finals. eg. Top team section 1 will play 2nd placed team in section 2 etc....
A one minute break between halves.
4. Drawn Finals – (i) there will be a minute break team changes/ substitutions can be made (ii) 2x3 min halves are played with no substitutions/changes allowed (iii) if scores are still tied play continues until one team has a two goal lead. Any team not on court ready to play a FINALS game will be given automatic forfeit.
5. Games shall consist of two seven minute halves with 30 second break at half time. First named team takes centre pass. In case of injury NO EXTRA TIME WILL BE PLAYED. Although umpires will allow for any injured player to be replaced.
6. Players may only play for one team throughout the day.
7. To be eligible to play in finals a player must have played at least once during the day with the team concerned.
8. All teams MUST SUPPLY ONE NON- PLAYING BADGED UMPIRE. It is expected all umpires will be available for finals.
9. All players and umpires must be currently registered with Netball Vic.
10. All matches to be played under Netball Victoria rules.
11. The tournament will be held regardless of weather conditions.
12. Twelve members of the winning and r/up teams will receive trophies.
13. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to re-grade teams.
14. The Association will not be responsible for accidents, injuries or lost property.
15. First Aid will be available only for injuries occurring on the day.
16. Teams not ready on court to play in any final will have automatic forfeit.
17. Canteen facilities will be available on the day Soup, Pies, Salad Rolls, Drinks. A BBQ will also be available with breakfast rolls, sausages & hamburgers.
